

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PAINT AUTHORIZING THE COOPERATION WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF PAINT FOR THE PROVIDING OF POLICE SERVICES BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PAINT TO THE BOROUGH OF PAINT AND THE ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF PAINT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2009-4, the Borough of Paint disbanded its police organization effective December 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Paint ("Paint Borough") desires to engage the police organization of the Township of Paint ("Paint Township") to provide police services to the residents of Paint Borough; and

WHEREAS, Paint Township has agreed to provide the aforesaid services to Paint Borough;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED this 10th day of December, 2009 as follows:


1. Paint Township agrees to provide municipal police services to the residents of the Paint Borough in accordance with the terms and conditions of the "Joint Municipal Agreement For Law Enforcement Services" which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A" pursuant to and under the authority of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act of July 12, 1979, No. 180, as amended (53 Pa.C.S.A. Section 481 et seq.).
2. The appropriate officers of Paint Borough are authorized to enter into the attached Joint Municipal Agreement For Law Enforcement Services with the Township of Paint and execute any and all other documentation necessary to effectuate this Ordinance.


